RULES & GUIDELINES

Welcome to The Dorset Tractor Run, please read the following rules and guidelines to ensure a safe and enjoyable day for everyone involved.

Schedule

- The run will commence at 11:00 - listen out for the claxon!
- The run will return to the start/finish point
- A pasty Lunch will be available once all tractors have returned.
- The raffle will be drawn after lunch.

Driving

- Please make sure you have read the terms and conditions that you signed when entering the tractor run, these are available from the Show Secretary if needed.
- Drive carefully – do not do anything to endanger yourself, passengers or anyone around you.
- The route is made up of public roads and private tracks – keep to the route, follow the tractor in front of you, stay in single file, no overtaking.
- If you break down ask for help, a number of drivers have tow ropes and jump leads, there will also be a mobile mechanic on the run.
- Be respectful – do not damage crops, verges or gardens, keep engine noise to a minimum when close to residential areas.
- Stay as a pack! Do not lose sight of the tractor behind or in front of you, slow down or speed up so everyone follows correct route.
- **Do not use your horn** while on the Dorset Tractor Run

Refreshments/Raffle

- Lunch is included in your entry fee, drinks must be purchased separately.
- You must present your ticket to get lunch – no ticket, no lunch.
- Refreshments before and after the run will be available to purchase at the start/finish point.
- Following the Run a donation will be made to the Dorset County Hospital Charity, and their new Emergency Department and Critical Care Unit - Dorchester Agricultural Society's nominated charity for 2023. All money collected from the raffle will be included in this donation
