NOTES TO STOCKMEN

LIVESTOCK ARRIVAL: Livestock may arrive on the Showground between 12.00 and 20.00 on Friday 1st September and between 06.00 and 08.00 on Saturday 2nd September.

The Showground Holding Number is 11/126/8000

PASSPORTS: All movements must be registered with BCMS. Passports will be required to be seen by any Show Steward or Show Official. No animal is permitted on the Showground without a valid passport.

BCMS: BCMS barcode labels will be issued for your cattle passports and given out with your cattle numbers at the Cattle Steward's Office on Show Day.

FACILITIES: Hot showers and loos are available from midday on Friday 1st September.

STOCKMAN'S BREAKFAST: A cooked breakfast will be available from the Country Kitchen on Saturday and Sunday morning. Each exhibitor will be sent two complimentary tickets for the Stockman's Breakfast. Additional tickets may be ordered at £8.50 with entry form.

STOCKMAN'S SUPPER: A subsidised two course supper will be served in the Members' Pavilion on Saturday evening. All beverages to be purchased. Tickets are available at £16.00 but must be purchased in advance.

DEFRA REGULATIONS: Please report immediately to your Section Steward's Office with the relevant movement licences and passports for your animals upon arrival to the Showground. Vehicles visibly contaminated with animal faeces will not be permitted to enter the Showground.

ADMISSION TO THE SHOWGROUND: All persons wishing to gain access to the Showground on Saturday and Sunday must produce a valid entry ticket. Vehicle passes do not admit the driver or any passengers. Exhibitor tickets will be issued prior to the Show as per the allocation noted below. Additional discounted Exhibitor Tickets are available, these must be **purchased in advance. Please contact the Show Office or add the required amount to your entry.** Please ensure that you have adequate passes for your individual requirements.

PASSES: Exhibitors may purchase advance Show passes at a reduced rate of £17 per ticket. Children under 16 enter the Show for FREE.

LIVESTOCK & CAR PARKING:

Livestock Parking: Livestock exhibitors will be issued with vehicle passes as illustrated in the above table. Livestock Parking will be accessed through Gate 1. Vehicle passes do not admit the driver or any passengers.

Public Car Parking - Public car parking is available free of charge.

Disabled Parking - There will be a designated area for Disabled parking at the front of the Public Car Park, please show your Disabled Parking Badge to the car parking attendant.

TB PRE-MOVEMENT TESTING: All Cattle attending the Show must have had a pre-movement test with a negative result within sixty days of the last day of the Show. Ask your Vet if they are offering FREE PRE-SHOW TB TESTING - several are offering this service in support of Agricultural Shows.

STALLING: The Show will provide 1.5m(5ft) per animal entered and 1m(3ft) per exhibitor for Show boxes/kit. This is from Friday afternoon, no divisions available. Please indicate on the entry form how many cattle you are bringing.

DEPARTURE: Cattle may not leave the Showground until after the Grand Parade on Sunday has been completed.

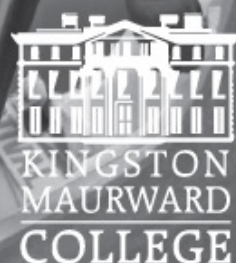
