**266 FOUR STALKS KALE, any variety with roots**

**267 FOUR STALKS MAIZE, with roots**

**268 CLAMP SILAGE, approximately 5 kgs of Silage, to be displayed in two gallon buckets.** State if first or second cut, name of Contractor (if used) and date of cutting

**269 BALE SILAGE, approximately 5 kgs of Silage, to be displayed in two gallon buckets.** State if first or second cut, name of Contractor (if used) and date of cutting
